Cookies in the cookie jar game

The cookies game is a fun and quick game to play and practice a range of skills. By writing targets for skills to practice on the cookies the game can be used to target many different skills, including:

- Sight words e.g. walk, the, you, a, see
- Letters of the alphabet e.g. Aa, Bb, Cc, Dd
- Numbers e.g. 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9
- Simple math problems e.g. $3 + 4 =$, or $2 \times 2 =$
- Speech sounds e.g. to practice the /f/ sound words could be 'fish, fun, fat, fan, fence' etc.



How to make the game:

- Print out the pages in colour, preferably on card stock to make it more durable
- Laminate all the pages
- Cut out the individual cookies
- Use a whiteboard marker to write the targets on the back of each cookie

How to play the game:

- Place all of the cookies in a container that is not see through, including the **Mudpie!** piece
- Players take turns to select a cookie from the container and say the word or solve the problem
- Players get to keep the cookie and place it on their cookie jar if correct, or they return it to the box if incorrect
- A player who pulls the **Mudpie!** card has to return all the cookies back to the shared box.
- The player with the most cookies when all of the cookies have been drawn from the container is the winner.

Other ways to play

- Have question cards for any skill you wish to practice and collect a cookie for each correct answer
- Roll a dice and collect that many cookies in a turn for correct answers to questions
